

Tea Together Crackle Paint

Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Tea Together (148779); Crackle Paint (148752)
- **Card Stock** – Blushing Bride (131287); Night of Navy (106577); Very Vanilla (106550)
- **Stamp Pads** – Blushing Bride (147100); Night of Navy (147110)
- **Misc.** – Tea Time Framelits (1149697); Basic Jewels Pearl (144219); Dimensionals (104430); Aqua Painter (103954)

Measurements:

- Blushing Bride: 8½" x 5½" scored at 4¼" (21cm x 14.8cm scored at 10.5cm)
- Night of Navy: 5½" x 1¼" (14.8cm x 3cm) 5½" x ⅜" (14.8cm x 1cm)
- Very Vanilla: 2 pieces each 5¼" x 4" (13.8cm x 9.5cm)

Instructions:

1. Stamp the front of the Blushing Bride cardstock with the Crackle Paint stamp and Blushing Bride ink.
2. Attach the larger strip of Night of Navy about ⅜" (1cm) from the bottom of the card front.
3. On one piece of Very Vanilla, stamp the tea cup with Night of Navy ink, stamp the medium flower three times with Blushing Bride ink, and stamp the 'Love is a warm cup of tea' sentiment with Night of Navy ink.
4. Die cut the tea cup and the three flowers with the matching Framelits. Die cut the sentiment with the same die as the flowers.
5. Colour the centre of the flowers with an Aqua Painter and Blushing Bride ink. Use Dimensionals on the three flowers, overlap them and attach to the top left corner of the card front. Add a small pearl to the centre of each flower.
6. Stamp the small rose randomly on the tea cup and saucer with Night of Navy ink.
7. Add colour to the roses with an Aqua Painter and Night of Navy ink.

8. Use Blushing Bride ink and an Aqua Painter to add colour to the tea cup and then attach it with Dimensionals on the right hand side of the Night of Navy strip on the card front.
9. Adhere the sentiment to the card front just above the cup.
10. Attach the smaller strip of Night of Navy about 3/16" (0.5cm) from the bottom of the other Very Vanilla piece. Stamp the small rose stamp in the right hand corner above the Night of Navy strip using Night of Navy ink. Attach the vanilla piece to the inside of the card.
11. Stamp the small rose stamp in the lower left hand corner of the envelope with Night of Navy ink.
