

To A Wild Rose Macaron Rococo



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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – To A Wild Rose (149452)
- **Card Stock** – Rococo Rose (150888); Whisper White (106549)
- **Stamp Pads** – Rococo Rose (150080); Mint Macaron (147106)
- **Misc.** – Wild Rose Dies (149547); Dimensionals (104430); Pearlized Doilies (146936); Pearl Basic Jewels (144219); Wink of Stella Glitter Brush (141897)

Measurements:

- Rococo Rose: 8½" x 5½" scored at 4¼" (21cm x 14.8cm scored at 10.5cm)
- Whisper White: 4" x 5¼" (9.5cm x 13.8cm) scraps for die cuts and sentiment

Instructions:

1. Stamp the large outline rose image randomly over the front of the Rococo Rose card base using matching ink.
2. On the scrap white, use Rococo Rose ink to stamp the outline rose image twice and then using the two-step stamping method, add both of the solid images inside of the outline. (OPTIONAL. Do a test rose with the three stamps on scrap paper. You may wish to stamp off the darker of the solid image before adding to the outline image.) Die cut the two roses.
3. On the scrap white, use Mint Macaron ink to stamp the outline leaf five times and then using the two-step stamping method, add the lighter of the solid images inside of the outline. Die cut the five leaf sprigs.
4. Cut one of the doilies in half, then arrange it with two more doilies and attach to the card front.
5. Attach the roses together and then add leaves as desired. I cut some of the leaves to achieve my look. Add dimensionals to the back of the flower / leaf panel and attach over the doilies.
6. Brush Wink of Stella over the roses.
7. Add some pearls.

- Stamp part of the outline rose image on the lower right hand corner of the large white piece for the inside of the card. (OPTIONAL. Stamp the envelope to match.)
