

## Quiet Meadow Many Messages Very Versailles Vintage Cake

### Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Quiet Meadow (155082); Many Messages (154510); Very Versailles (149275)
- **Card Stock** – Crumb Cake (121685); Very Vanilla (106550); Basic White (159228)
- **Stamp Pads** – Memento Tuxedo Black (132708); Crumb Cake (147116); Old Olive (147090)
- **Misc.** – Stitched with Whimsy Dies (155314); Messages Die (154422); Linen Thread (104199); Square Vellum Doilies (152484); Detailed Trio Punch (146320); Watercolor Pencils Assortment 1 (141709); Blending Brushes (153611)

### Measurements:

- Crumb Cake: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" scored at 4 1/4" (21cm x 14.8cm scored at 14.8cm)  
4 3/4" x 2 3/4" (12cm x 7cm)
- Very Vanilla: 5 1/4" x 4" (13.8cm x 9.5cm)
- Basic White: 1/2 sheet to stamp and die cut Messages sentiments

### Instructions:

- Using Crumb Cake ink and images from Quiet Meadow and Very Versailles stamp sets, stamp on front of card base. Stamp some images first generation and some second generation to get depth to the collage.
- Use Old Olive ink and the leaves from Very Versailles on the left and right sides of the card base.
- Take the smaller piece of Crumb Cake cardstock and die cut one of the Stitched Whimsy Dies on three sides. Move the die over to the right hand side and die cut again. This may overlay two die cuts at the top and bottom, but it will look like it belongs.
- Use the Detailed Trio Punch to round the corners of this piece.
- Stamp the floral sprig from Quiet Meadow on the small Crumb Cake piece using Memento Tuxedo Black ink. Colour the flowers with the White Watercolor Pencil, the

centres of the flowers with the Daffodil Delight Watercolor pencil and the stems and leaves with the Old Olive Watercolor Pencil.

- Use second generation stamping with Crumb Cake ink and the 'splotches' from Quiet Meadow around the coloured flowers.
- Add extra Crumb Cake ink around the edge of both the card front and flower panel with a Blending Brush.
- Stamp and die cut the messages sentiments with Memento Tuxedo Black ink on Basic White cardstock. Choose the sentiment of your choice and add Crumb Cake ink with a Blending Brush.
- Add one of the vellum doilies to the top left of the card base and another one to the bottom right of the card base.
- Centre the flower panel on the card base.
- Tie a small bow with Linen Thread and attach to the base of the flower stem.
- Attach sentiment.
- Decorate the Very Vanilla cardstock and add to the inside of the card. Decorate envelope to match.
